### **YOU PROVIDE:**

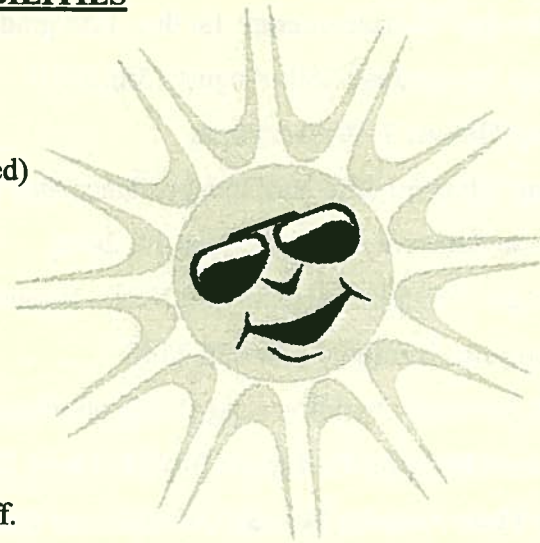
- Weekly Tuition

### **DISCIPLINE POLICY:**

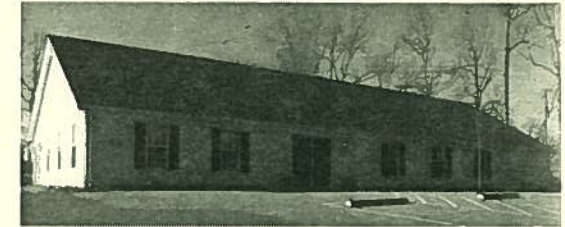
- Rules will be rehearsed daily and each child will be expected to abide by them.
- No profanity, defiant behavior, bullying, lewd acts or non-permitted materials or toys will be tolerated.
- IF Rules Are Broken:
  - 1st Time: Warning (staff will discuss the situation with the child)
  - 2nd Time: Time-Out (staff will discuss the situation and then child will be removed from others 10 minutes to contemplate their actions)
  - 3rd Time: Parents Called (parent will be called to discuss situation with their child)
  - 4th Time: Parents will be asked to pick up their child from the program for the remainder of the day.

\*\*\*If a child has 3 separate incidents that require a parent to pick them up, dismissal from the program may occur.

\*\*\*Staff Members will not be allowed to physically discipline a child.
